

Avigdor Gal is the Academic Co-Director of Data Science & Engineering for the Technion's undergraduate and graduate programs, and the head of the Big Data Integration laboratory in the Faculty of Data & Decision Sciences. In the current age of big data, his research is focused on developing novel models and algorithms for data integration. He is an expert in information systems and data science, and more recently, in machine learning and artificial intelligence. Gal has published more than 150 papers in leading professional journals and top conferences. Over the years, he won several best paper awards and in 2018 he won the test-of-time award at the DEBS (Distributed and Event Based Systems) conference, for the most influential research paper of DEBS'2008. He also authored the 2011 book *Uncertain Schema Matching*. He has won the IBM Faculty Award each year from 2002 to 2004 and the JPMorgan Faculty Award in 2019. He also won several Technion teaching awards, including the 2012 Yanai Award for Excellence in Academic Education. Prof. Gal serves in various editorial capacities and helped organize professional workshops and conferences nearly every year since 1998.
