

## Dražen Galić CV

Graduated from the Faculty of Civil Engineering in Rijeka in 1986, and master's degree from FAGG Ljubljana in 1992 in the field of geotechnics. From 1986-1996, he worked at the Faculty of Civil Engineering in Rijeka as an assistant and lecturer on the courses "Soil Mechanics and Foundations", "Use of Water Power". From 2007-2013, he worked as a part-time lecturer on the course "GIS in communal engineering" at the Faculty of Civil Engineering in Rijeka.

From 1996 until today, he has been working in the company StudioARS, d.o.o. Matulji as director and head of development. He is responsible for the development of the Urbano software, for the design and maintenance of underground pipe systems (water supply, sewage, ...). Urbano is an application within AutoCAD, sold throughout Europe and beyond and used by close to 3,000 users.

He participated in many IT implementation projects in construction, including GIS and BIM technologies in the field of infrastructure. He is one of the authors of the publication "Guidelines for BIM approach in infrastructure projects" published by the Croatian Chamber of Civil Engineers.
